Rewilding Award

Recognizes outstanding efforts in restoring degraded ecosystems and bringing landscapes back to their natural, self-sustaining state. This award celebrates initiatives that revive biodiversity, rebuild ecological balance, and promote long-term environmental resilience.

Naturenomics™ Award

Presented to an individual or organisation whose conservation-driven efforts have created a positive environmental impact while enabling sustainable economic opportunities. The award recognises innovative approaches that integrate biodiversity conservation with community livelihoods and long-term ecological sustainability.

Green Journalist Award

Recognizes journalists who have consistently brought attention to environmental issues through impactful storytelling. Their work raises awareness, influences public discourse, and inspires action towards conservation and sustainability.

Green Guru Award

Celebrates an exceptional educator or mentor who has inspired a deep appreciation for nature and conservation among youth and communities. Through innovative and engaging approaches, they nurture awareness and drive meaningful action toward wildlife restoration and environmental stewardship.

Young Naturalist Award

Honours young individuals who have shown remarkable curiosity, dedication, and initiative in understanding and protecting nature. Their passion and early contributions reflect the promise of future environmental leadership.

Food for the Future Award

Recognizes initiatives that promote sustainable, climate-resilient, and biodiversity-friendly food systems. This award celebrates efforts that ensure food security while conserving natural resources and supporting local communities and their livelihoods.

Forest Ranger and Guards Award

Presented to the frontline custodians of our forests - rangers and guards, who demonstrate exceptional commitment, courage, and resilience in safeguarding biodiversity across protected areas and reserve forests. This award recognises their vital role in protecting wildlife, maintaining ecological balance, and upholding the integrity of natural ecosystems through sustained, on-ground action.

Lifetime Service Award

Presented to an individual whose lifelong dedication has made a profound and lasting contribution to environmental conservation and community development. This award recognises sustained leadership, commitment, and a legacy of impact that has shaped ecosystems, empowered communities, and inspired future generations.

Indian Eastern Himalayan Grant

Supports individuals, organizations, or grassroots initiatives working towards conservation, restoration, and sustainable development in the Eastern Himalaya. The grant empowers innovative ideas that strengthen ecological resilience and community well-being.


